

History & Aims

Redgate Sanctuary was founded in August 1986 by Jean, Derrick & Tereza Redmile at Shaw Lane , Markfield. In the Beginning Rehoming a few sick & injured Animals soon escalated into rehoming Horses, Sheep, Goats, Pigs, Dogs, Cats, Rabbits, Ducks, Geese & even owls.

Due to the financial burden on the Redmile family, Charity status was obtained in March 1994. Obtaining Charity status has aided the Sanctuary in official capacities, however we now receive Animals through more channels than before , The Police, Other Animal Welfare Organisations.

A high portion of Animals are found new homes, for the others who are too ill, they live their days out at the Sanctuary. This is when the Sanctuary provides the special care, maybe veterinary care or special needs.
